



Costs associated with the AACP Stage Two Accreditation Assessment Process

Application fee – this includes both the annual fee and the assessment fee:

- General fee - **\$838.35**. You must lodge your application within three years of completing your Stage One (preparatory) Course. This includes your annual fee.
- Discounted fee –**\$670.70**. To be eligible for the 20% discount on the fee, you need to lodge your application within 30 days of completing your Stage One (preparatory) Course. This includes your annual fee.

Annual fee - **\$300.30** (payable one year after you lodge your application)

Other costs:

- Third attempt at the Clinical MCQ assessment - **\$110.07**
- Release of new case study (after two unsuccessful attempts at any of the case studies) - **\$104.61**
- Appealing a marker's decision regarding the assessment of a case study (see the AACP's *Appeals Policy*) - **\$123.30**

Accreditation fee – **\$824.45**. This is payable when you have successfully completed the Stage Two Accreditation Assessment process.

Reaccreditation fee - **\$643.15** Paid annually.

Note: The AACP does not have details of the cost of the stage one (preparatory) courses. This information is available from the stage one providers.
